

## Where We Spent Your Rotary Foundation Donations

### 2009-2010

#### Educational Programs –

- **Academic Year Ambassadorial Scholarship** – (Alexandra Pauluhn) – \$25,000. Studying Political Science & Diplomacy at the College of Europe in Brugges, Belgium.
- **Peace Fellow Program** –
  - Donated \$25,000 to fund one of the 60 Peace Fellows.
  - Donated \$2,500 to the Zone 30 & 31 – Heartland of America Peace Fellow Endowment, a joint multi-year effort of the 26 districts in Rotary Zones 30 and 31.
- **Group Study Exchange** – to Denmark District 1440 - \$13,000. Sent our team of six Missourians to Denmark to live in Rotarian homes and travel throughout the district for four weeks.

#### Humanitarian Programs –

- **District Simplified Grant** – we distributed \$25,606 to our clubs as Community Assistance Program Grants (CAP Grants). We approved 33 grants to 30 of our Rotary Clubs for use in local projects.
- **Matching Grants** – 12 grants were applied for and approved. We authorized the use of \$68,950 for these projects. Total project size was \$383,396.
  - **MG 70763** – we invested \$5,820. Total project size - \$27,940. Funded water project to bring clean water to 350 poor residents of Pimienta. Location: D4250-Honduras.
  - **MG 70901** – we invested \$4,000. Total project size - \$53,512. Funded 2,515 cataract surgeries for poor people around Bangalore. Location: D3190-India.
  - **MG 70938** – we invested \$9,091. Total project size-\$23,881. Funded 4 clean water projects at schools of Moradabad. Also funded 200 artificial limbs, 50 calipers, 40 hand-powered tricycles, 10 wheelchairs and 100 pairs of crutches for people in need. Location: D3100-Moradabad, India.
  - **MG 71114** – we invested \$4,709. Total project size - \$39,167. Funded 16 open heart surgeries for children born with heart defects. Location: D2980-Salem, India.
  - **MG 71139** – we invested \$2,500. Total project size - \$10,000. Funded 100 artificial limbs for people in need around Cochin. Location: D3201-Cochin, India.
  - **MG 71426** – we invested \$5,000. Total project size - \$50,267. Funded purchase and installation of 25 computers in two orphanages in Cluj. Location: D2241-Romania.
  - **MG 71528** – we invested \$4,000. Total project size - \$50,445. Funded purchase and installation of dental chair for wheelchair-bound patients in clinic with approximately 15,000 patient visits each month. Location: D2440-Izmir, Turkey.
  - **MG 71554** – we invested \$12,915. Total project size-\$23,515. Funded the installation of water well, with tank and spigots and solar powered pump for Djoliba village of 6,500 residents. Location: D9100-Mali.
  - **MG 71670** – we invested \$10,406. Total project size - \$23,908. Installed new water well for hospital and community of Tanguieta. The hospital serves approximately 25,000 patients each year. Location: D9100 – Benin.
  - **MG 71875** – we invested \$10,509. Total project size - \$30,909. Purchased medicines and medical equipment for children of the village of Yako. Location: D9100-Burkina Faso.
  - **MG 72092** – local Rotarian invested \$12,098. Total project size - \$24,196. Funded 2 projects to improve schools of Udupi region. One school receiving furniture, cabinets, computer equipment and lab equipment; the other school receiving a new toilet facility. Location: D3180-Aadi Udupi & Parkala, Udupi, India.

## Where We Spent Your Rotary Foundation Donations

- **MG 72484** – we invested no district Foundation funds. Total project size - \$25,656. Funded a water project, including well, pump, tank, piping and spigots for Miguta village including a medical dispensary that serves approximately 15,000 each year. Location: D9200-Kenya.
- **Matching Grant Summary** – we invested \$68,950. Total projects size - \$383,396. AWESOME !!!

## Summary

- In 2006-2007 we donated \$308,518.84 to the Annual Programs Fund.
- Then, in 2009-2010:
  - We invested \$63,606 of our Rotary Foundation donations directly on Missourians or in Missouri.
  - We invested another \$68,950 on 12 International projects in 8 other countries.
  - We donated \$31,525 to PolioPlus
  - Through our funding of all these projects, both locally and overseas, we also controlled the spending of an additional \$366,561.
